What is Home Stretch?

The Assessment Center (AC) portion of the National Board Certification process consists of six exercises, each designed to elicit evidence of the Candidate's fundamental content knowledge as outlined in the Standards for that specific certificate area.

KEA Home Stretch is an optional full day professional development event for National Board candidates preparing to take the Assessment Center and wanting to receive focused feedback on one portfolio entry. Home Stretch is relevant for full candidates—first time and advanced. KEA is proud to bring the latest in candidate support from our colleagues in the Washington Education Association.

Who is Eligible?

Each seminar will be limited to the seating capacity at each facility: 40 at both Madisonville and Morehead, and 80 at Gheens. Participants should be registered with National Board and have their Authorization to Test (ATT) documentation.

Registration cost for the one day session is \$55 for KEA members and \$95 for non-members. The registration fee provides materials, light breakfast, lunch, snacks and beverages. Part of your fee also provides an honorarium to each of the NBCT trainers who contribute their time to make this event a quality experience.
